CCSS is heavily focused on language (oral, written, collaboration, etc.) and an increased emphasis will address the needs and progress of English Learners. LCFF will be a projected 8 year implementation process with current funding noted as being less than adequate to fund full implementation. The advice given in various formats, both formal and informal, is to proceed with financial decision making with extreme caution. The projected financial outlook is moderate over the next few years, but is likely to take a down-turn 3-5 years out.
